RE-SELECTION FOR RESIDENCES NEXT YEAR

Places offered to residents are valid to the end of the current academic year. There is no guarantee of re-selection from one year to the next. The Director of Student Life may receive more applications than places available and this means that there may be a competitive selection process. Consideration for re-selection takes into account contribution to the residential community and general conduct within the residential accommodation.

Students applying for on-site accommodation and who meet the above standards will have rooms allocated on the following basis:

- First choice - Residents from the previous year will be allowed to return and will have first choice of the room you held in the previous year if you apply by Friday 15 November 2013. After this date room allocation will be determined by date of application.

If another room is vacant and you wish to move rooms, you can request a change of rooms. If more than one person requests the same room the Director of Student Life will determine to whom it will be allocated.

- Second choice - Any remaining vacant rooms will be given to commencing students. Within this group, priority will be given based upon date of receipt of application for residential accommodation and/or demonstrated need to live on-campus (e.g. coming from overseas).
- Third choice - Continuing students who were not residing on-campus at the end of the previous residential period.
