### Introduction

These figures are indicators of the academic performance across a program of study. Only subjects studied at Campion College that are part of the standard Bachelor or Diploma programs are included. Above-load subjects not required for graduation such as Latin are excluded.

### Definitions

- i. The **Grade Point Average** is determined by assessing the grade (e.g. Credit; Pass) received in each subject in the course to determine an average. It is calculated using the following formula:

$$\frac{\text{Sum of (credit points for subject x GPA value of grade)}}{\text{Sum of credit points attempted}}$$

Grades have the following GPA values:

High Distinction	7.0
Distinction	6.0
Credit	5.0
Pass	4.0
Terminating Pass	3.0
Fail	0.0

- ii. The **(Weighted) Average Mark** is determined by assessing the mark (e.g. 68; 73) received in each subject in the course to determine an average. It is calculated using the following formula:

$$\frac{\text{Sum of (credit points for subject x mark)}}{\text{Sum of credit points attempted}}$$

The final average mark is rounded to the nearest integer.
