Statements of more than 150 words, or received after the close of nominations, will not be accepted.

Delivery and receipt of nominations

Nominations must be lodged at the Reception Office by 4pm on **Thursday, 21 March 2019**.

A ballot will be held if there is more than one nomination for any of the vacant positions.
