9. Accept the diversity of backgrounds and beliefs of other residents.
10. Not make excessive noise at any time, but especially after 10:00 pm.
11. Not use or store illicit substances.
12. Not act in a reckless or dangerous manner that potentially can cause harm to self, others or damage the facilities.
13. Not tamper with the fire safety system or equipment or smoke, use incense, candles or oil burners in bedrooms.
14. Take responsibility for the security of your own property & the property of others.
15. Not leaving any personal items (clothing, books) or equipment around the College.
16. Take responsibility for your actions.
17. Maintain open and honest communication with other students and staff at all times.
18. Smoke only in the designated smoking area near the pond.
19. Abide by the alcohol policy: Hours for alcoholic beverages are: Friday 5 – 10pm, Saturday and Sunday 12noon – 10pm. Beverages permitted are Beer and Wine only.
