



CREDIT ON OFFER FOR 'STUDIES IN CATHOLIC THOUGHT' STUDENTS

Students who complete *Studies in Catholic Thought* as part of their Higher School Certificate are now eligible to receive credit towards Campion College's undergraduate courses thanks to a new Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) agreement.

Upon enrolling at Campion College, any NSW-based student who has completed *Studies in Catholic Thought* will now receive credit towards two level-100 theology units, effectively reducing their first-year workload by 25 per cent.
